## An Overview

The project was to develop a circa. 600 space car and coach park at Castle Hill in Dudley which supported the development of a leisure-led mixed use visitors attraction in the Town Centre. The overall Castle Hill project has the objective of creating a cluster of sustainable tourism and leisure attractions which contributes towards the revitalisation of Dudley Town Centre.

## The Outcomes

Through Growing Places Funding, this project has:

- Provided an environment of support particularly for SME's helping them foster growth and contribute to the region's regeneration, including partnership with Aston University.
- Delivered an Enterprise and Innovation Centre consisting of 130sqm within Dudley Town Centre.
- Supported facilities, design and development areas with computer design and testing facilities as well as rapid prototyping and 3D modelling machines.
